REMOVE CAMERA BACK DOOR AND INSERT BATTERY





/ Camera Essentials



POWERING CAMERA ON AND OFF

To power ON	To power OFF
Press the Power/Mode Button [②].	Press and hold the Power/Mode

/ Selecting Camera Modes

Turn camera **ON** and repeatedly press the Power/Mode Button [**②**] to cycle through camera modes.



/ Camera Settings*

TO ADJUST CAMERA SETTINGS:

- 1. Press the Power/Mode Button [9] to cycle to Settings mode [$\overset{\bullet}{\mathbf{A}}$].
- 3. Press the Power/Mode Button [()] to cycle through options.
- 4. Press the Shutter/Select Button [] to select desired option.

/ Capturing Video + Photos



Press the Shutter/Select Button [] to start/stop recording or take a photo.

You can change video and photo settings in the Settings menu [\ref{N}].


DEFAULT VIDEO SETTING: 960P30 FPS

Your camera is set to 960p 30 fps, which delivers a large viewing area and smooth footage. It's great for a wide range of shooting scenarios, including gear- and body-mounted shots.

If you want to experiment with other video settings, you can find more info in the Camera Settings section of the User Manual.

DEFAULT PHOTO SETTING: 5MP

Your camera is set to 5MP resolution.



/ Connecting to the GoPro App

The GoPro App lets you control your camera remotely using a smartphone or tablet. Features include full camera control, live preview, playback and sharing of select content and more*.

- Download the GoPro App to your smartphone or tablet at the Apple App Store, Google Play or Windows Phone marketolace.
- Press the Power/Mode Button1 to power camera ON.



- Press the Power/Mode Button
 1 to cycle to GoPro App, then press the Shutter/Select Button
 1 to select it.
- In your smartphone or tablet's Wi-Fi settings, connect to the network called "GOPRO-BP" followed by a series of numbers/ letters. Enter the password "goprohero"**.
- Open the GoPro App on your smartphone or tablet.


